



## Viewing Properties with JW Wood during Coronavirus

As the country moves to living with coronavirus, JW Wood still have a number of procedures in place to help keep you and our team safe when the risk of infection of Covid 19 is still possible. The governments advice on moving home can be found [here](#) and this explains the minimum best practices that should be followed.

Our offices are now staffed although all visits remain by appointment only. Simply telephone or email the office and wait for confirmation of a day and time before attending, we will be asking anyone attending our offices to wear a mask unless unable to.

In order to protect you, our clients, and our team whilst any viewings are taking place, the following will be in place.

- We will first offer you a virtual viewing (where available) of the property and wait for your feedback if you would like to proceed with a physical viewing.
- We will ask you to complete a brief Coronavirus (COVID-19) Health declaration form on behalf of everyone in the viewing party, prior to us confirming your appointment.
- We request that all parties wear a suitable face covering, however in some cases our client may make wearing a suitable face covering a condition of viewing the property (unless exempt).
- Social Distancing is no longer a requirement, but we recommend that distance is still maintained during the viewing where possible.
- All parties viewing a property should wash their hands with hand sanitiser immediately after entering the property.
- Anyone who has been identified as a close contact of a confirmed case but is exempt from self-isolation will not be allowed to view the property, during the usual isolation period.
